



SCOPE OF SERVICES

GASTROENTEROLOGIST

The Contractor shall communicate with the Chief Executive Officer designated by that Officer in connection with the performance of the duties under this Agreement and shall fulfil any other duties reasonably requested by the Employer and agreed to by the Contractor.

During the period of this Agreement, the Contractor shall ensure that the services performed pursuant to the requirements hereof shall conform to all applicable laws and regulations promulgated by the legally constituted Authorities of the government of Trinidad and Tobago.

Tasks

The Contractor would be required to:

1. Provide Gastroenterology expertise in liaison with the Surgical or Internal Medicine unit.
2. Liaise and partner with the current surgical led endoscopic service at Sangre Grande Hospital to increase efficiency and productivity aiming to provide a full time endoscopy service five (5) days a week across both specialties.
3. Provide two (2) four (4) hour sessions clinic per month to assist in management of conditions including but not limited to:
 - Inflammatory bowel disease including Crohn's Disease and Ulcerative Colitis
 - Liver disease
 - Gastroesophageal reflux disease and
 - Gastric and duodenal ulcers.
4. Provide at least a twice (2) weekly Gastroenterology scope services.
5. Selected outpatients will be seen in the Clinic, accompanied by resident doctors. These doctors will assist with the conduct of the clinic and the coordination of patients, therapeutic modalities and investigations. Doctors will generate a roster for rotation through the clinic with the contractor.
6. Be available for call out on and emergencies.
7. Be part of a multidisciplinary team in the planning of the management of these patients. This may include consultations with other medical and para-clinical team members.
