4. ORGANIZATIONAL RELATIONSHIP

The Health, Safety & Environment Technician will have a dual reporting relationship with the Primary Care Physician II and Occupational Safety and Health Officer.

5. NATURE & SCOPE

The Health, Safety & Environment Technician assist in the prevention of harm to workers, property, the environment, and the general public. Health Safety & Environment Technicians take measurements and collect workplace data either for routine inspection or as directed by the Manager-Occupational Safety and Health. The incumbent works under the supervision of the Primary Care Physician and Occupational Safety and Health Officer, and also help to implement and evaluate safety programmes.

6. SPECIFIC ACCOUNTABILITIES

The Health, Safety & Environment Technician:

- □ Ensures hazard register & conformance reviews are facilitated and kept current.
- □ Assists with the implementation of objectives and targets in a manner consistent with procedures.
- Ensures Health and Safety training needs are documented within the Health and Safety Training Matrix.
- Assists in the delivery of Health, Safety and Environment training.
- □ Conducts compliance audits as per Health, Safety and Environment Audit Programme and provide reports for same.
- Maintains the Health Safety and Environment manual and communicate its use and application to appropriate personnel.
- Follows up on items in and maintain the corrective and preventative action register.
- Ensures Job Hazard Analyses (JHAs) produces reflect appropriate identification of hazards and suitable controls.
- Assists in formulating general safety policies and procedures to be followed by company personnel in compliance with local, state and federal rules and regulations.
- Advises company personnel on proper planning of job activities and equipment usage to insure safe environment, perform audits to check for safe/unsafe acts and conditions.
