ERHA COVID-19 Vaccination Report

Vaccines are one of the tools being used in the fight against the COVID-19 virus.

The first phase of the ERHA's COVID-19 Vaccination Programme commenced on April 06, 2021 targeting persons 60 years and over with Non-Communicable Diseases (NCD's).

The ERHA made a strategic decision to commence the rollout of the vaccines at the Sangre Grande Enhanced Health Centre, Toco Health Centre, Mayaro District Health Facility and the Rio Claro Health Centre to provide access to persons in the easv surrounding communities. Staff were also called upon to manage the vaccination process for essential workers at the National Racquet Centre, Tacarigua.

Members of staff came forward and led the way as they got vaccinated to protect themselves, their families and the communities they serve.

Additional members of staff will be able to access the shuttle service to journey to facilities as far as Matelot in the North East and Guayaguayare in the South East to provide healthcare services.

The Authority will also be able to increase its reach in the communities under its health promotion caravan with the provision of the 2nd bus which was provided by the Ministry of Health. This is an extension of the *TTMoves Campaign* and is aimed to encourage members of the communities to make healthier lifestyle choices.

World Kidney Day Lecture

490 clients are now empowered to make lifestyle changes about Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD) after participating in a lecture series hosted by the Health Education Department, Andrew/St. David.

The sessions were conducted at health facilities during the period March 9, 2021 to April 29, 2021. They explored the risk factors of CKD which include family history, uncontrolled diabetes, high blood

pressure, recurrent urinary tract untreated infections, kidnev stones, and drug and alcohol use.

Also discussed were the five stages of CKD and simple prevention tips which included: the benefits of quitting smoking, avoiding alcohol, eating a healthy diet, managing your diabetes, physical activities, usina as prescribed medication drinking sufficient water.
