



SCOPE OF SERVICES

UROLOGIST

The Contractor shall communicate with the Chief Executive Officer or any other party designated by that Officer in connection with the performance of the duties under this Agreement and shall fulfil any other duties reasonably requested by the Employer and agreed to by the Contractor.

During the period of this Agreement, the Contractor shall ensure that the services performed pursuant to the requirements hereof shall conform to all applicable law and regulations promulgated by the legal constituted Authorities of the government of Trinidad and Tobago.

Tasks

The Contractor would be required to:

1. Provide Urology expertise with the liaison department General Surgery.
2. Provide weekly four (4) hour clinic sessions to manage conditions including, but not limited to:
 - Benign Prostatic Hyperplasia (BPH)
 - Prostate cancer
 - Renal calculi
 - Renal cancer
 - Hydronephrosis
3. Provide weekly surgical list in liaison with the General Surgery department.
4. Selected outpatients will be seen in the Clinic, accompanied by resident doctors. These doctors will assist with the conduct of the clinic and the coordination of patients, therapeutic modalities and investigations. Doctors will generate a roster for rotation through the clinic with the contract.
5. Be available for call outs and emergencies.
6. Be part of a multidisciplinary team in the planning of the management of these patients. This may include consultations with other medical and para-clinical team members.
