6. SPECIFIC ACCOUNTABILITIES

The Specialist Medical Officer (Mental Health):

- Organizes, plan and direct all activities in a hospital or perform specialist medical work in the field of mental health for the department
- Establishes work schedules and ensure efficient and adequate medical coverage and participants in Hospital training programmes.
- Conducts initial assessment for first-time patients in out-patient clinic.
- ☐ Initiates and direct staff conferences to discuss medical problems for instructional purposes.
- Directs and supervise the work of junior medical officers.
- Administers emergency medical treatment to patients and serve as a Consultant to Medical Officers of a more junior level.
- □ Provides medical treatment within a model of multi-disciplinary care
- □ Attends clinical team meetings and performing medical duties that are decisions of that meeting
- Compiles patient history from a number of sources, and preparing case summaries and discharge summaries
- □ Prepares reports for Mental Health Review Tribunals and Managers' Hearings and provides advice where necessary evidence
- □ Liaises with other clinical teams within and outside the trust
- Liaises with general practitioners and medical specialists with regards the physical health of the patients
- Provides specialist assessments relevant to the service e.g. Forensic, Learning Disabilities, CAMHS etc.
- Trains junior medical officers, nurses and nursing assistants, and other hospital staff, or other persons as part of outreach programmes
- Performs related work as may be required by the appropriate Authority.

7. KEY KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

- □ Extensive knowledge of the principles, practices, techniques and modern developments in the field of Mental Health.
- □ Knowledge of the administrative practices and procedures, rules, policies and standards related to the Mental Health Department
- Ability to examine patients, diagnose, prescribe and administer necessary treatment in the specialty of Mental Health
- Ability to organize and supervise the work of junior medical officers, and to guide and advise them on medical matters
- Ability to gain the confidence and co-operation of patients and to establish and maintain effective working relationships with other employees and the public
- ☐ Must be able perform and report echocardiograms, stress echocardiogram/ stress tests, trans esophageal echocardiograms and 24-hour Holter-monitors.

- A minimum of seven (7) years' medical experience in Psychiatric Services.
