SPECIFIC ACCOUNTABILITIES The Ultrasonographer I would be required to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">❑ Performs various ultrasound procedures and examinations on patients and process results from these procedures.❑ Ensures that the ultrasound room is prepared for daily examinations and conducts necessary quality assurance tests.❑ Registers patients and manages patient flow and work schedules.❑ Ensures that the patients are properly prepared and fully aware of the processes involved in the examination.❑ Utilizes ultrasound equipment prudently for performing examinations.❑ Maintains proper standard of performance according to regulations and guidelines❑ Records studies for radiological interpretation.❑ Prepares technical reports for presentation to the reporting Radiologist.❑ Resolves queries from various departments, wards and patients.❑ Assists in the training of Interns.❑ Performs related work as may be required by the approved Authority.
