6. SPECIFIC ACCOUNTABILITIES

The Psychologist:

- Provides Psychological Assessment and Evaluation.
- Provides crisis intervention in situations requiring immediate psychological treatment.
- Provides psychological consultations to other mental health professionals within hospitals, clinics and other community-based agencies with regard to patient care.
- Attends and participates in ward conferences.
- Devises and conducts appropriate psychotherapy.
- Responsibility for the teaching of both undergraduate and postgraduate psychology students.
- Collaborates and participates in activities in planning and development of the Psychology Services in the department and institutions.
- Ensures the integrity of patients' medical records.
- Develops and maintains standards of care for patients.
- □ Assists with research projects.
- □ Prepares and conducts seminars, lectures and workshops on mental health education.
- Keeps in supply relevant testing materials and other materials necessary for the efficient functioning of the Psychology Services.
- Participates in departmental committee and staff meetings.
- Performs any other related duties as required by the Authority.
